<b>January</b>	Attend a Volunteer Training session (90 minutes)
<b>January 17<sup>th</sup></b>	Student application deadline
<b>Feb 1<sup>st</sup> – Feb 17<sup>th</sup></b>	Read and score the applications for discussion and deliberation via online system
<b>Feb 18<sup>th</sup> – March 2<sup>nd</sup></b>	In-person Review team deliberation meetings (1 meeting approx. 2 hrs.)
<b>March 6<sup>th</sup></b>	MAC Scholar Athletes will be announced
<b>May</b>	Scholarship Celebration – all scholarship volunteers are invited to join us!

### **MAC SCHOLAR ATHLETE PROGRAM**

*Open to high school sophomores*

#### **Criteria**

Those who are of good character and citizenship can be nominated by their high school's committee if they meet the following:

- I. Must not be a current MAC member;
- II. Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA;
- III. Participation in competitive high school athletics;
- IV. Exhibits strong character and leadership involvement in their school and community.

#### **Opportunity**

- Each program high school can nominate up to three high school sophomores each year. One student athlete will be selected per school.
- Access to the Multnomah Athletic Club throughout his or her high school tenure and the opportunity to a club membership at the age of 26.
- \$1,500 one-time award toward his/her college education within six years of high school graduation funded by the Foundation.

#### **Process and Timeline**

School with nominate up to three candidates. The nominated individuals submit their application via the online system. Our trained review teams will evaluate and select one student from each high school to be part of the MACSA program.
